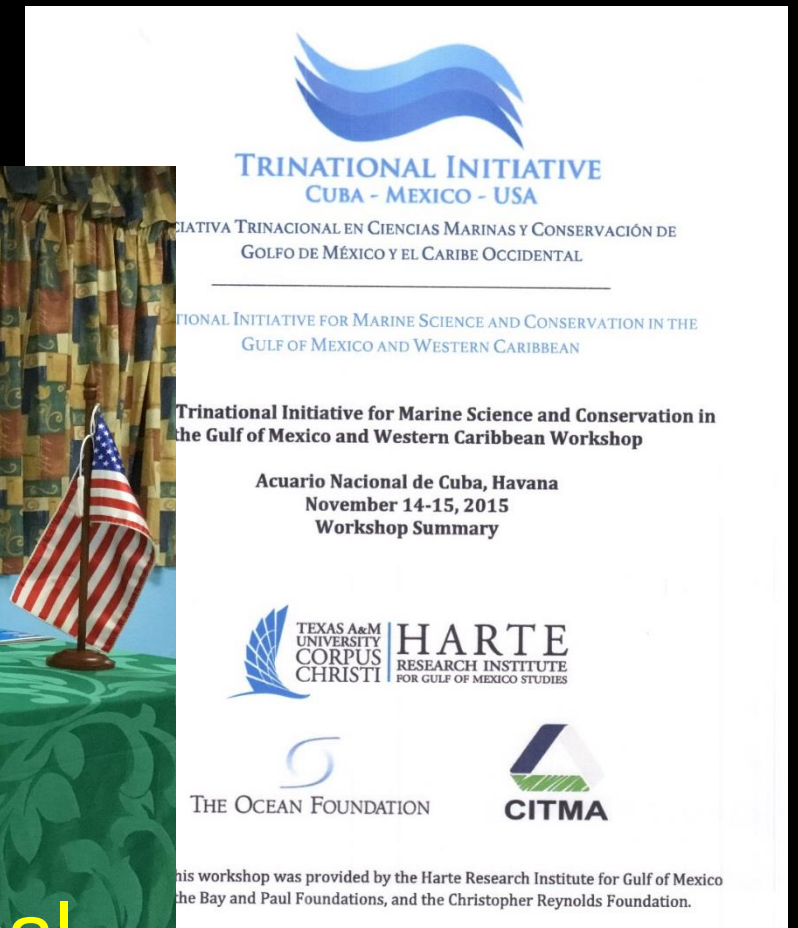

Furgason Fellowship Endowment

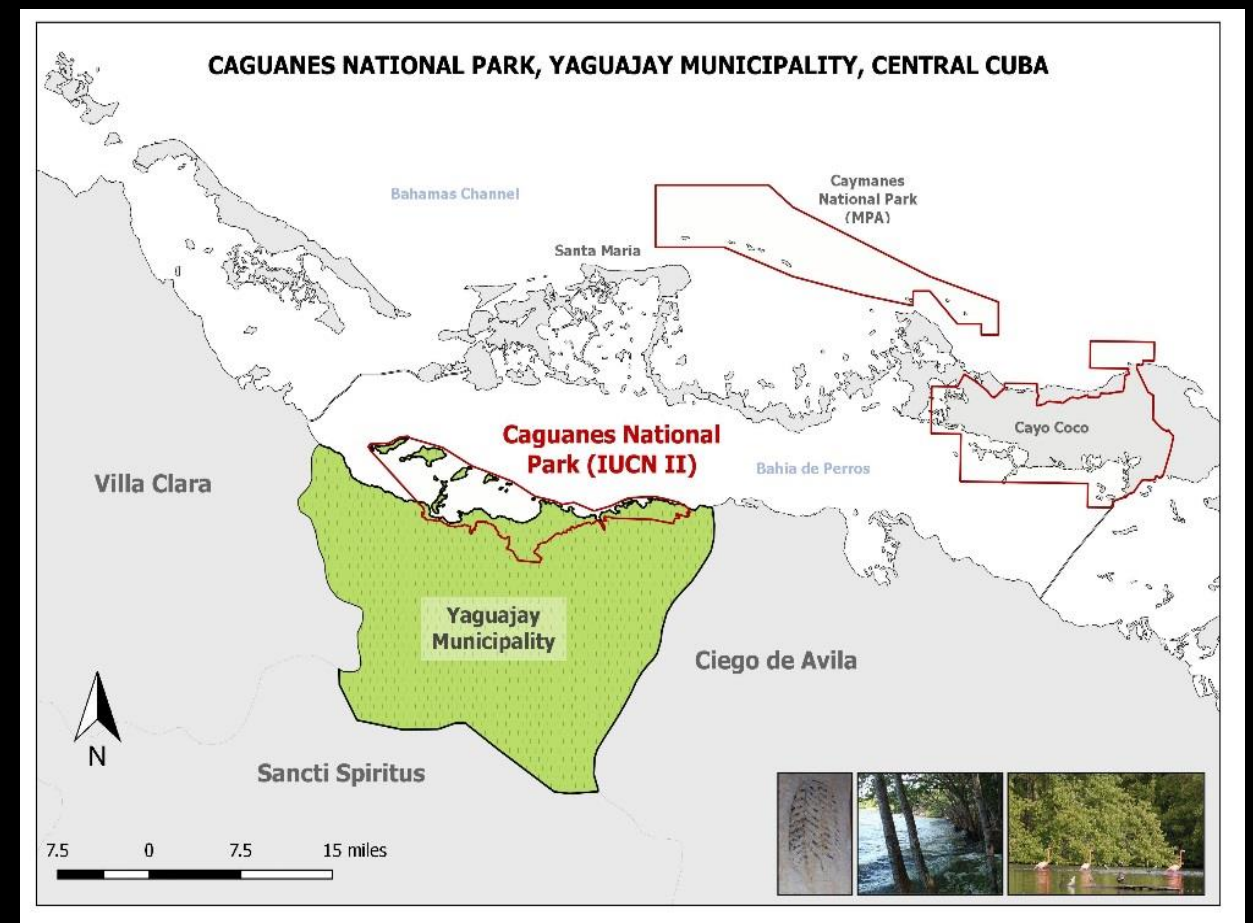

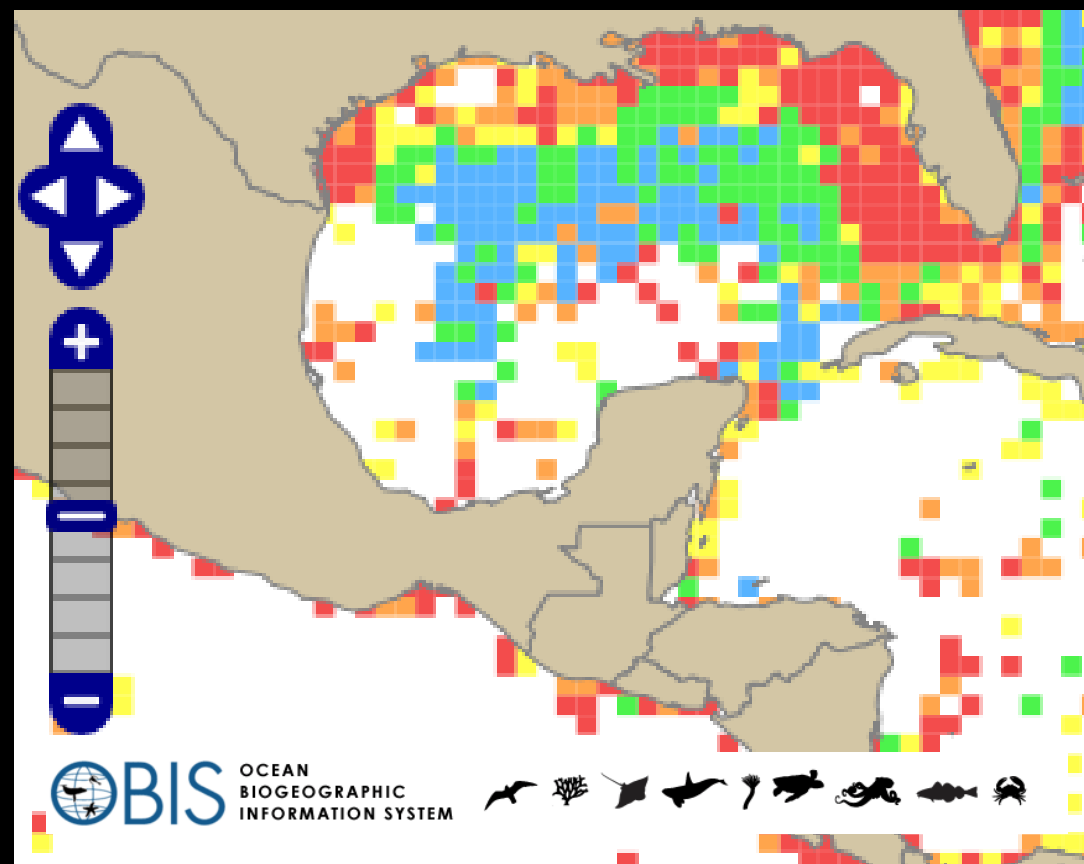
Furgason Student Workshops on International Management (SWIM)

Integrates USA, Mexican and Cuban graduate students in learning and engagement experiences while addressing emerging resource issues in the rotating host country.





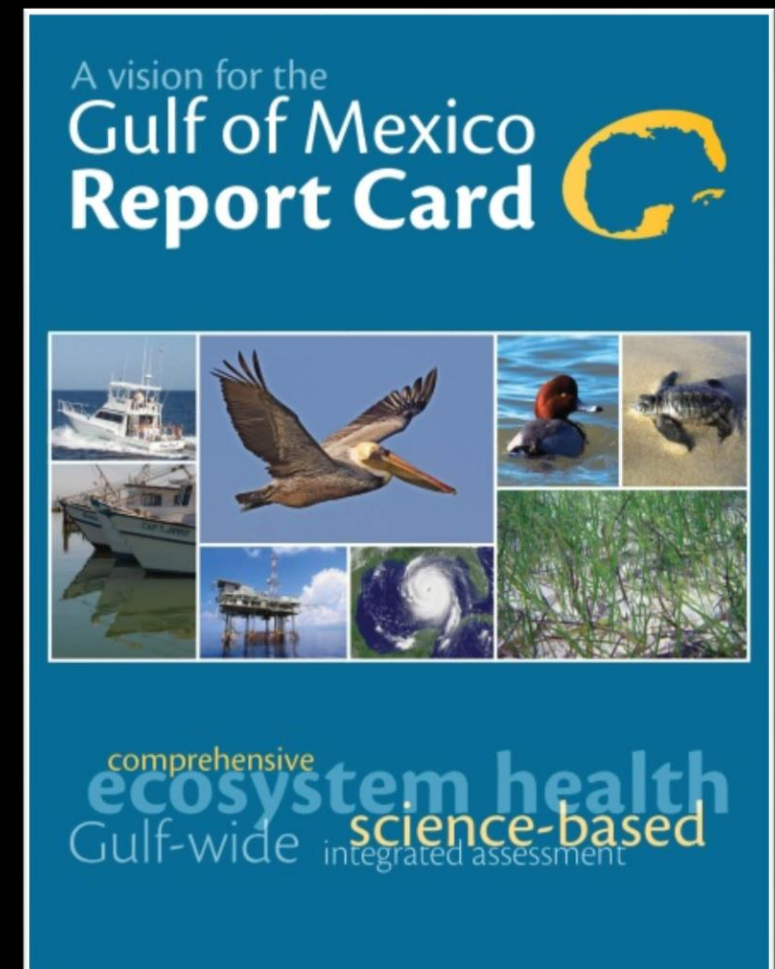
HRI International Endowed Chair - Biodiversity (Mexico)
